### ALL ARE SENT

Fifty days after Easter Sunday we celebrate the fulfillment of all God's promises in the feast of Pentecost, a feast that has sometimes been called the birthday of the Church. One last time we are reminded that we Christians have received the Holy Spirit, not for our own benefit, but to enable us to follow our Christian vocation.

The centerpiece of the scriptures for Pentecost is the account in Acts of the Apostles of the sending of the Holy Spirit to the disciples. The other readings for this Sunday help us to understand what it means to live out our Christian vocation. Paul's letter shows us the gifts and fruits that the Holy Spirit gives to us. John's Gospel reminds us that Jesus has sent all his disciples to share his forgiveness and peace, through the power of the Holy Spirit.

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In *God's Word is Alive* (ACTA Pub) spiritual author Alice Camille offers this reflection for Pentecost Sunday: Gospel John 20:19-23

"As the Father has sent me, so I send you."

The contrast between Luke's version of the sending of the Spirit and John's is remarkable. Where Luke shows us fire and excitement, John emphasizes peace and forgiveness.

Peace and forgiveness. An inseparable bond exists between the two. The unforgiving and the unforgiven live without peace, mutually tied to the sin which divides them. Peace requires forgiveness and forgiveness restores peace. Even as Jesus gives his disciples the gift of peace, he bestows the power of binding and loosing sin through forgiveness.

Our willingness to forgive others sets them free to live at peace again. Our desire to hold them bound is a refusal of the gift of Christian peace. The celebration of the church's anniversary at Pentecost is a time for both Luke's version and John's. We must be that church aflame with the Spirit of the resurrection. And we must also be the community of forgiveness. This is the peace the world cannot give. If it does not come from us, from whom will it come? If a sacred wind blew through your life, what would be blown away? If a holy fire lit in your heart, what would you be led to do?

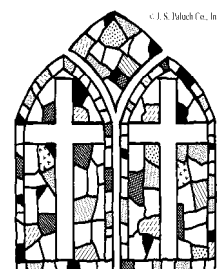

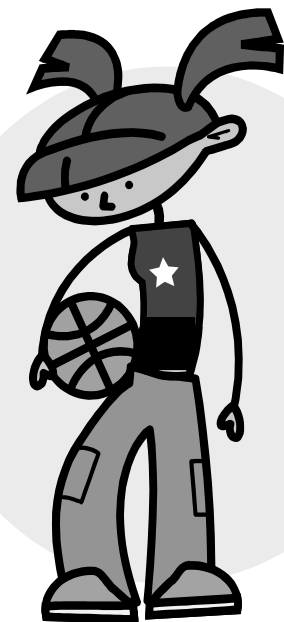
